Since then the Shroff Eye Clinic has been associated with the latest instrumentation and technology in the field of ophthalmology first in the country to do modern retinal surgeries in 1962 with the use of implants, cryosurgery for retinal detachment and cataract [1968], fundus fluorescein angiography [1970], Xenon arc photocoagulation, the precursor of the argon laser [1973], microscopic cataract surgery [1975], vitrectomy [1978], Argon laser, Krypton laser, phacoemulsification and A scan sonography [1983]. The Shroff Eye Clinic contributes significantly to the development of new techniques.
